Environmental conservation and sustainable energy go hand-in-hand in the Black Forest, as demonstrated by the current 148 KONUS locations with some 10,000 hosts offering the KONUS Guest Card. The KONUS Guest Card provides free rides on all public transportation buses and trains throughout the entire region. It is valid for 2nd class travel in all nine transport sectors.

Leave the car parked and ride buses and trains for free when hiking, making discoveries, or going shopping: All made possible with the KONUS Guest Card. It provides free rides on buses and trains throughout the Black Forest - as often as you want and entirely free. It's the only ticket you'll need!

How do you get KONUS?

Register with one of 148 Black Forest holiday locations to receive your KONUS Guest Card when registering with your host. **Note:** Some types of accommodation (such as youth hostels and clinics) are exempt from the visitor tax and therefore are unable to issue a KONUS Guest Card. Be sure to ask your host about the KONUS Guest Card before booking.

How long is validity, and where is it accepted?

The KONUS Guest Card is valid throughout the duration of your stay for 2nd class transportation on all regional buses and trains from participating transportation providers, as well as on trams and buses in the cities of Freiburg and Karlsruhe.

Note: Exceptions are ICE-, IC-, EC- and ECE connections as well as mountain railways and funiculars.

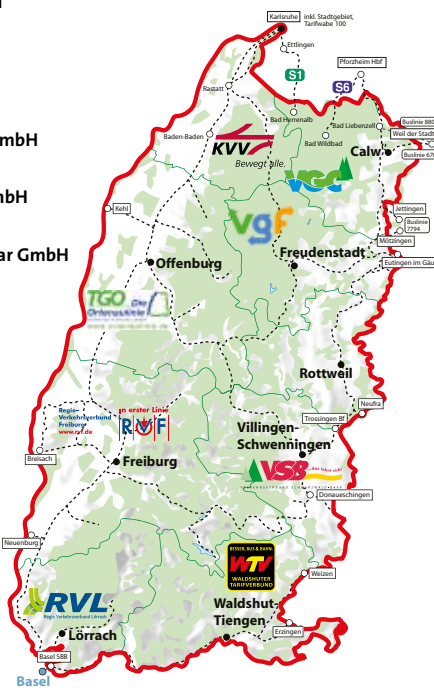

General Terms and Conditions. With KONUS, you ride for free!

The portion of visitor tax paid by a local gov't for KONUS is currently 42 cents per night of accommodation.

- KONUS is valid for **2nd class regional transportation** within the KONUS region; see outline map (does not include ICE, IC, EC, ECE trains or mountain railway).
- The KONUS Guest Card is only valid if **filled out completely (including total number of persons and departure date)**. If you are not yet able to determine your departure date, please enter the presumable date for your departure. Under the German Registration Act, you are required to register stays of more than three months (if you have a German residence, after six months) with the local registration office (including address) within two weeks.
- Do not write** on the KONUS Guest Card **directly**. If the registration form is filled out by hand, then a carbon copy has to be produced in the presence of your accommodation provider. The electronic Guest Card will be produced by your host. Supplemental changes made directly on the KONUS Guest Card will render it invalid for public transportation.
- KONUS is **only valid for people**. It does not cover free transportation for animals or bicycles. To that end, the respective tariff provisions from the transport companies and associations apply accordingly.
- KONUS is only valid in connection with a valid photo ID of the person whose name appears on the KONUS Guest Card. That person must also be personally present when the KONUS Guest Card is being used by a group.
- The KONUS Guest Card is **not transferrable**.
- If you have registered as a group yet wish to use KONUS as a ticket for individual group members, then you can obtain individual KONUS guest cards from your accommodation provider by presenting and exchanging your KONUS group guest card. We recommend having individual KONUS guest cards issued when you register if you won't always be traveling as a group.
- In the interest of securing transportation, groups of more than 10 persons traveling together must be registered with the respective transportation authority at least three days prior to starting their journey. Groups fundamentally can only be taken onto buses within the respective transport company's scheduled capacity. It is not always possible to accommodate all transportation wishes, especially during times of heavy traffic. When registering directly with the transportation company, you'll receive either confirmation or alternative suggestions.
- KONUS is valid starting on the day of arrival upon arriving at your accommodation provider (check-in) until the day of departure. KONUS can be used for the departure journey, but not for the arrival journey.
- You can obtain information on the participating transportation associations, regional limits and the KONUS region from your accommodation provider and/or the local Tourist Information Offices, or on the Internet at www.konus-schwarzwald.info. If your journey exits the KONUS region, then the regular transportation fee must be paid starting from the final location in the KONUS region.

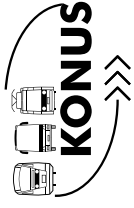
Please be sure to comply with these Terms and Conditions as well as the general transportation terms and conditions of the participating transportation associations and overlapping transportation companies.

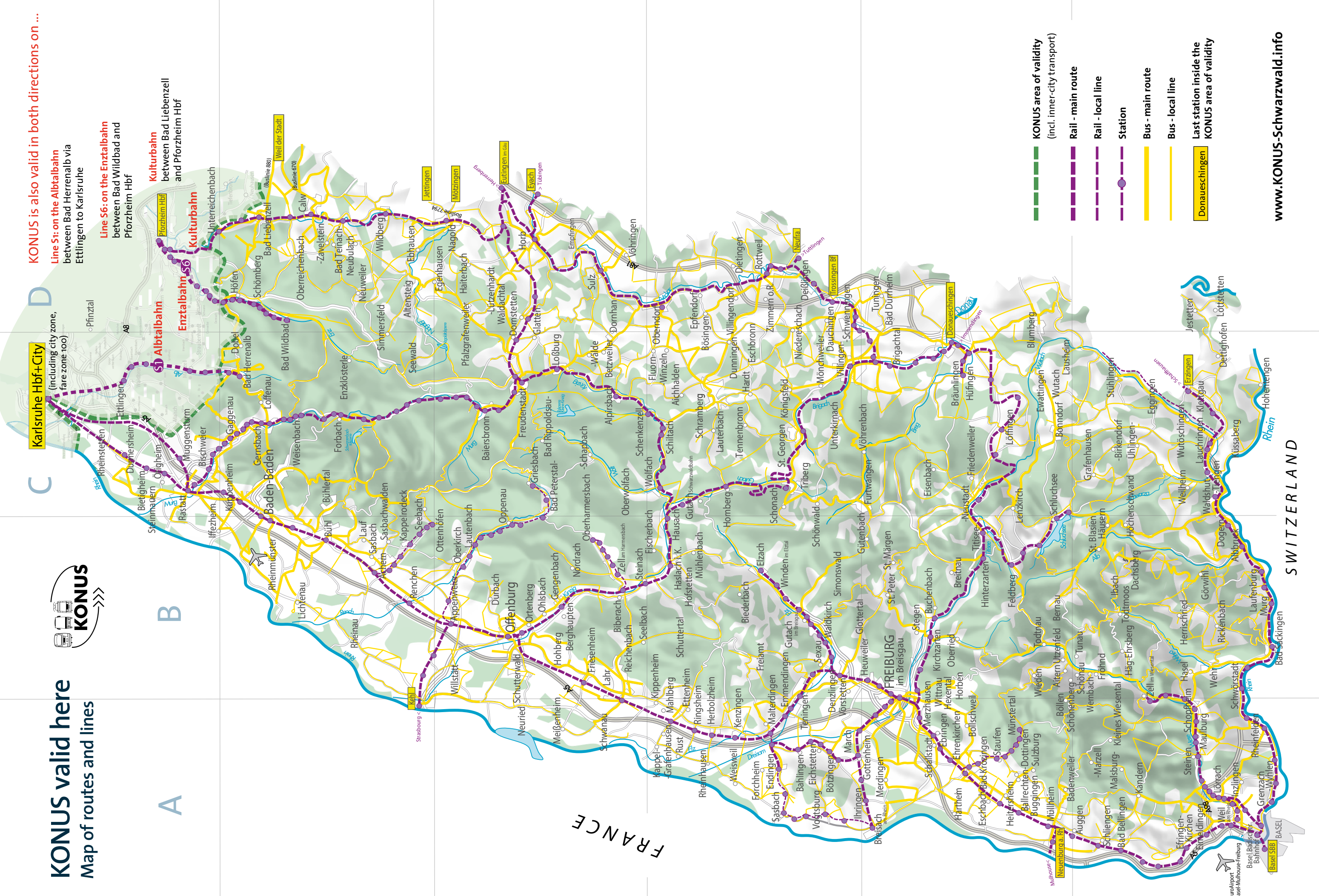
